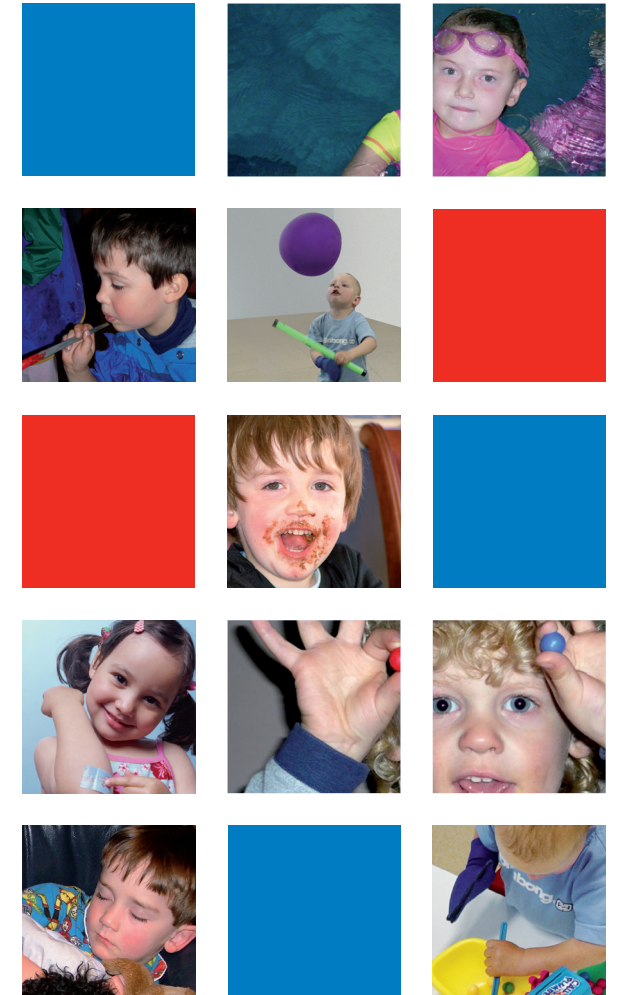

What is VPRS?

The Victorian Paediatric Rehabilitation Service caters for children and adolescents who require specialist interdisciplinary rehabilitation. This rehabilitation may be as an inpatient at The Royal Children's Hospital or Monash Medical Centre or with in the community at all sites.

VPRS Aim

VPRS aims to provide all Victorian children who require specialist rehabilitation the ability to access the services that they need, when they need them and in the most appropriate location no matter where the family lives.

Who is Eligible?

To be eligible for VPRS the young person should be aged between 0-18 and:

- Have had an acquired injury, medical/surgical intervention or a functional impairment
- Have moderate to high complexity rehabilitation needs and / or require time limited and goal focused programs
- Requires an interdisciplinary team approach to achieve their rehabilitation goals
